

Directions to Auchgoyle Bay Cottage, Minard

We hope these directions will help you find the holiday cottage and the photos should highlight a few landmarks to look out for once you get into the village.

Most people arrive by car, travelling south from Inveraray.

Approx. 10 miles from Inveraray you will enter Minard village.

About a quarter of a mile into the village you will see a turning for Victoria Park. Pass this and turn off the road by the old church (see picture).



This short road takes you across a bridge and up a short hill to the terrace where the cottage is located.

Please be aware that children sometimes play in this area.



Auchgoyle Bay Cottage is immediately after the taller building in the centre of the terrace.



If you miss the turning you will see a bus stop to your left and the terrace with Auchgoyle Bay Cottage on your right.

Turn right at the first opportunity.

If you reach the traffic lights you have gone too far.



This is the turning to take if you missed the first turn off the main road.

If you are travelling north from Lochgilphead you will find this turning approx. 50m on your left after the traffic lights.



If you arrive by bus from Inveraray this is the view of the terrace from the bus stop. There is only one bus stop in each direction in the village.

If you are arriving from Lochgilphead the bus stop is just after the terrace by the old church.



The village and cottage are easy to find as there are few turnings that take you off the main road. SatNav users should enter the postcode **PA32 8YD** as this takes you to the road outside the cottage.

If you stop and ask for directions, just ask for **Lower Achagoyle** or the **post box**. There is another property in the village with a similar name as the cottage.

The postal address is 4 Lower Achagoyle, Minard, Inveraray PA32 8YD and the terrace of houses and shop is known as Lower Achagoyle.
